Leicester Ky. March 30 1864

Dear Uncle

The 9th A C passed
through this place this P.M.
on its way to Cincinnati, O.
and from there to Annapolis
Md. We left Knoxville
Tenn on the 20th inst.

I have been quite unwell
for two or three days with
from the effects of a bad
cold and hard marching
and was left here to take
the stage in the morning
and shall rejoin the Regt
again tomorrow at
Nicholasville

I sent a box by Express to
you from Camp Nelson
on the 25 January containing

a heavy blue Cap and a
pair of shoes I have not
heard from you since
in fact we have not
received but letter mail
You will please send
them to the Galt House
Cincinnati as soon as
you ^{receive} get this so that I
can take them when we
pass through that place
I should like you a
call before leaving the
West if it were possible
but there is no officer in
the Co beside myself
I should like very much to
see you and Aunt again
before going East
With much love in haste
