and also a motion made by your Delegates for Pay for the ship Hambden agreeable to your Request and the Report of the Committee to whom it was referd. which I make no doubt will be as disagreeable to you as it was to me true it is Congress are in grate want of money at this time but as they had granted some Reliefe to the state of the massachusetts they ought to have done the same by newhampshire when the worst comes to the worst we must due our selves Justice. I did not move for Pay for the Cloathing being advised by my friends to postpone it at this time and wait a more favorable opportunity. I am S^r with grate
