

Oxford June 22^d 1779

Sir

Yours of the 2^d of this instant yesterday came to hand wherein you mention to make return of the names of the men enlisted agreeable to orders sent in April last which orders I never have received, nor never knew of any Orders until the 2^d of yours. The last orders were dated January 9th 1779 requesting me to make a return of the men that enlisted into the Continental Service for three years, the return of which hath been made and forwarded at three different times - Any orders that are of a public nature and require dispatch, I should think ought to be forwarded by some safe way of conveyance that might be depended upon, otherwise at such a distance they often miscarry and the public Service neglected for which we shall be very uneasy, as we ever have done and hope shall ever continue to do our proportion in that way -
