Sir,

Agreeable to appointment, I send my
son Major Stark to make a final settlement
with the state in my behalf untill the first
of January 1782. and his settlement shall be con-
sider'd on my part as much as if done by myself
after the settlement of the ballance should appear
in my favour (as I presume it will), I wish to
have a note ^{or notes} given for the ballance, in the same
form, and payable at the same periods that those
of other officers of the State are.

I have directed Major Stark to take upon
settlement, four oxen, and two or three W^o of
corn, if you should think it expedient
upon which is to be deducted from my account.
