Surety of the Peace Against him the said Hooper

These are therefore in his Majestys Name to Command
you to Cause the said Thomas Hooper to Come before
me the Subscriber or Some other of his Majestys
Justices of the Peace for the Province aforesaid to find
Sufficient Security as well for his Personal Appearance
at the next General Quarter Sessions ^{to be holden at Portsmouth} of the Peace for
the Province aforesaid then and there to Abide and do what
shall be enjoined him by the said Court As also in the
mean time to keep the Peace towards all his Majestys
Good Subjects And Especially towards the said Henry
Thresher — And if the said Thomas Hooper shall
Refuse so to do that then you Convey him to the Goal
aforesaid And Deliver him Safely to the Keeper
thereof. Commanding you also the aforesaid Keeper
to Receive the said Thomas Hooper into your Custody
And him safely Keep untill he shall find such Security
as aforesaid or be Discharged by Due Course of Law
Hereof fail not Given Under my hand and Seal this
thirteenth day of June in the 26th Year of his Majestys
Reign Annoque Domini 1753
