 Mariner Testifieth and saith That he was at Louisbourg on the 15th
 of December 1754. upon the Sabbath Day being then Indebted to Mr. Boulow
 a French Merchant there He came to the Depont. & told him some body
 had hinted to him that the Depont. would come no more to Louisbourg
 and therefore he the Depont. should not go from thence till he had
 paid him the s^d. Boulow or given him security for his Debt
 upon which the Depont. ask'd him ^{how} that could be done He Answer'd
 that the Depont. should give him his Order on Mr. Bobisang (as
 he ow'd the Depont.) to be paid in the Spring - Accordingly the
 Depont. gave the said Boulow order on the s^d. Bobisang who
 accepted the same in presence of the Depont. and after
 deducting out said Order Bobisang is Indebted to the Depont.
 near or about Six Thousand Livres for Supplies of agreea
 Num. of Cattle & for Two years - As for Mr. Robert Brober
 saying it was on aul^t of the Sloop that was taken from the
 Depont. at Louisbourg The Depont. Declares and says it was
 not, For that Sloop was sold at Vendue & the Judge of
 Admiralty took security of Bobisang for the pay which
 Cap^t. Dalton the Depont. apprehends knows something of.
 Upon the Whole The Depont. Declares and says that He
 hath not any Goods, Effects, Moneys or Credits in his Hand
 of the abovesaid Boulows nor doth he the Depont. owe
 Him One Farthing.
