The United States in Congress Assembled on the twenty third of June last directed me to take Measures for the Speedy launching and equipping for Sea the Ship America. I am therefore to request that you will furnish to John Langdon Esq: such Sums of Money as may be necessary for that Purpose which is to be on Account of the Requisitions of Congress on your State, I am also to request Sir that I may be favoured as soon as may be convenient with an Account of the Sums furnished so that they may in the Treasury Books be carried to the Credit of your State and W Langdon be debited for them. It is of the utmost Importance to many Public Objects that this Ship should soon be at Sea I am therefore confident that your Excellencys Efforts will be cheerfully made for that Purpose.
