In Congress 21 May 1779.

Resolved,

That these United States be called upon, in addition to the sum required by Resolution of Congress of the 2^d Jan^y. last, for their respective quotas of Forty Five Millions of Dollars to be paid into the Continental Treasury before the first day of January next in the proportion following

Resolved,

That the said several Sums, or any greater Sums which shall be paid by any of the States into the Continental Treasury, shall be paid to their respective Credits on Interest, on the same terms as are prescribed by the resolution of Congress passed the 22^d January 1777.
