Assembly Entituled an Act for granting to his
most Excellent Majesty the Sum of four thousand
Seven hundred and twenty pounds Bills of Credit on
this Province Equall to Proclamation Money
and to an act in addition to said Act for the
more Effectual Collecting Province Taxes

You are in his Majesty's Name Required to
make an Equal and Impartial Assesment on all Dells &
Estates within said Hampton Falls Precinct Rateable
by law to the amount of thirty three pounds Sixteen Shil-
lings and Six pence like Bills of Credit and Comitt
a List thereof to the Constable for said Precinct Requie-
ring him to Collect and pay the said Sum to the Treas-
urer of said Province for the time being at or before
the first day of February next in said Bills of Cre-
dit or in Such Species at Such Prices as are Enume-
rated in said Act

You are also required to
make Returne to said Treasurer of the Constables name
and Sum he is to pay, as you will avoid the Penal-
ty provided in said Additional Act
