belonging to the Company aforesaid were
on or about the Twentieth Day of ^{at Hampton Falls N.H. Province aforesaid} April last
Impressed for his Majesty's Service for the
Expedition Against Canada to go in a Regiment
to be Raised in the Province aforesaid and were
Ordered to attend said Duty, notwithstanding
which they have Neglected to attend their
Duty in that Respect and have Deserted the
Said Service. You are therefore hereby
Required forthwith to take the Bodies
of the said Samuel Towe & Edmund Mason
if they may be found within your Limits
and bring them before me at ^{Hampton Falls}
in the Province aforesaid to be Dealt with
As to Law and Justice Appertain And I Do
hereby Require all officers and Soldiers
Under me to assist you herein as Occasion
shall Require: And make Return
