 you what I want see long first I told him he should have it last Saturday  
 but he went out of Town same to the Tavern less than 15 moments  
 after he was gone, I sent to several places to find him but I could not

 pardon the trouble I now give you when you quit it in my power  
 I will Gladly Return the favour, should he be so unkind enough to  
 send the Execution into the officers hands in that case dont pray
