

Letter from Paul Sullivan

Sir

Head Quarters Providence July 29th 1775

I have the Pleasure to inform
the Council, that the French Fleet
came to anchor off Point Judith
to Day at twelve o'clock and the
Pilots have all gone on Board. I wish
the Ships from New Hampshire may
be forwarded with all possible Dispatch
as I am particularly desirous for my
own State Men to share the Honor of glorious
an undertaking; and should be sorry that
the Expedition should fail thro' any Delay
on our Part
