This Indenture Witnesseth that Jonathan Dilton Benjamin Sweet Samuel Lane Abraham Dow & Richard Smith Yeoman Select Men of Hampton falls in the Province of New Hampshire by & with the Assent of Jabez Smith & Meshack Weare Esqrs two of His Majestys Justices of the Peace for Said Province Have put & bound and by these Presents DO Put & bind Margaret Walker a poor Fatherless Child belonging to Hampton falls aforesaid to be an Apprentice unto Jonathan Moulton Junr of Hampton in Said Province Shopkeeper and with him the Said Jonathan Moulton Junr. after the Manner of an Apprentice to dwell & serve from the Day of the Date hereof until she the Said Margaret shall come to the Age of Eighteen years according to the Law of Said Province in that Case made & provided During all which Said Term the Said Apprentice her Said Master honestly & faithfully shall serve his Secrets keep his Lawful & Reasonable Commands every where gladly DO & Perform Damage to her Said Master she shall not wilfully do her Said Master's Goods she shall not waste Embezel Purloine or unlawfully lend to Others, nor suffer the Same to be wasted or Purloined but to her Power shall forthwith Discover & make known the Same unto her Said Master, Taverns or Alehouses she shall not frequent, at Cards Dice or any Other unlawful Game she shall not play, Fornication she shall not commit, nor Matrimony Contract with any Person During the Said Term from her Said Masters Service she shall not at any time unlawfully Absent her Self but in all Things as a good honest & faithful Servant & Apprentice shall bear & behave her Self towards her Said Master During Said Term

And the Said Jonathan Moulton Junr. Doth hereby Covenant Promise & Agree unto & with his Said Apprentice in Manner & Form following That is to Say that he will find & Provide for & unto his Said Apprentice good & sufficient Meat Drink Washing Lodging & Apparel suitable for an Apprentice During Said Term, also will learn Said Apprentice to Read, and at the end of Said Term will Dismiss Said Apprentice with two Suits of Apparel the One New the other for Common Wearing, In Testimony Whereof the Said Parties to these present Indentures have Interchangeably Set their Hands & Seals
