

West Point July 15th 1780

Dear Col^l

I send by Capt Hawkins a list of promotions for the officers of my Brigade Directed to Col^l Ware, which I beg you will wait on him & urge the completion of their appointments as other States have lately promoted theirs

Also send you a list of those men which have deserted since you sent them Returns to Coeter last march would have you apply to the Committee of Safety to advertise them in the New Hampshire papers & offer a reasonable Reward to any person who will secure them so that they may be brought to Camp, as you may be assured that unless some spirited measures are speedily taken to prevent desertions we shall soon have no men in the field

Benj^r Cretchet Ebenezer Fosgood & Sumell Allen of Capt Warts Comp^y deserted ten days ago were taken at Casport and brought back


My interest shall be given to get them hanged
or that they had forged ~~for~~ signatures in
my name. Nothing must be transpired
since you left camp.
