an account of the quantity of Wheat and other grane bought
by me also what has bin sold what there is now on hand and
what there is that may still be bought if money is furnished soon
from Charlestown upward on & near Connecticut River

Amount of Purchases about - 4,600 Bushels of Wheat and
nearly - - - - - 1,000 of other Grane - -

have the greatest Reason to ^{believe} that there is now to be bought
within those limits Nine or Ten thousand Bushels of Wheat
and other grane if the money can be soon paid I am now
indebt for the above Stores & other Expenditures at least
fifty thousand Dollars
