In Congress Nov^r 30th 1780

Resolved

That it be recommended to the several States immediately to inform the Com^y General and Deputy Com^y of the Names of the principal Agent or Commissioners respectively for supplying the Army, and to oblige them to give Information from time to time to the Commissary Gen^l or the Deputy Commissary with the Southern Army as the Case may be of their Prospects and how far they shall be able to comply with their Requisitions.

That the live Stocks to be furnished by the several States be delivered to such Storekeepers within each State at such Times and in such Quantities as the Commissary Gen^l or the Dep^y Com^y shall direct under the Regulations contained in the Act of Congress of the 15th July last for the Delivery of all other public Property
