British gain upon us in Virginia. Pennsylvania  
Maryland & Delaware militia are raising (too slow)  
to meet them. The eastern Post, not  
arrived makes us apprehensive for its safety.  
Gen Sullivan is well, with whom I am very intimate.  
I shall be glad to hear from you especially on  
the subject of supporting your Delegates.
