Sir,

In consequence of your letter of the 29th Decemr.
last to John Gibson Esq^r late Auditor General, and on
the representation of the Hon^{ble}: M^{rs}: Beabody, an enquiry
has been made respecting the charge against the State of
New Hampshire the 25th of July 1778 for Two hundred
thousand Dollars; And it appearing that this charge
was made upon a Report being preferred to Congress
recommending an advance of that Sum to the State, but
which report did not at that time pass, and consequently
the charge premature; The Board of Treasury have
ordered the Entry to be reversed in the Books, by which
the State has now Credit for the sum mentioned, of which
I am directed to give you this advice; I have the
