I have the Honor to enclose an Act of the Governor and Council of this State, removing by Proclamation the Land Embargo, that has for some time subsisted.

We have not a doubt your State will readily concur with us in this Measure

'Tis thought by this State, that the restriction by Water ought still to be restricted with great Care and Strictness; — Not only that the Enemy may not be supplied that way — but that the States may not even by their own Trade, be drained of the Supplies which will be so necessary and essential for the supports of our own, and the Army of our Allies.

We doubt not your State will carefully and critically attend to these considerations
