I enclosed I send you a List of the Officers in the New Hamp: Line, candidates for Promotion with the Vacancies they have a right to fill — The long delay has so affected the feelings of some of them that they are become quite uneasy — The York Line have very lately received their Promotions, and I wish ours might be effected and the warrants sent on as soon as possible — By the enclosed copy of a Letter from General Washington to Capt Ashley you may see the Resolve of 21 March last has been mistaken and the Objections made by the Court last winter are obviated
