We were wakened up
early with the orders struck in our face
to march immediately. We are probably
going to East Tennessee as fast as possible
as we can carry but little baggage
My shirts and things I don't know
when I shall get as furloughs are probably
played out. I send a leaf of a tobacco plant
perhaps Father would like to see
also a ~~shuttle~~^{glass} and a glass stopper which
I got in Jackson. I want to hear from
home often shall try and write often
I intended to send home a great many
little things which I shall be obliged to
throw away.
