but I hadn't seen today's mail yet. Did you get any?

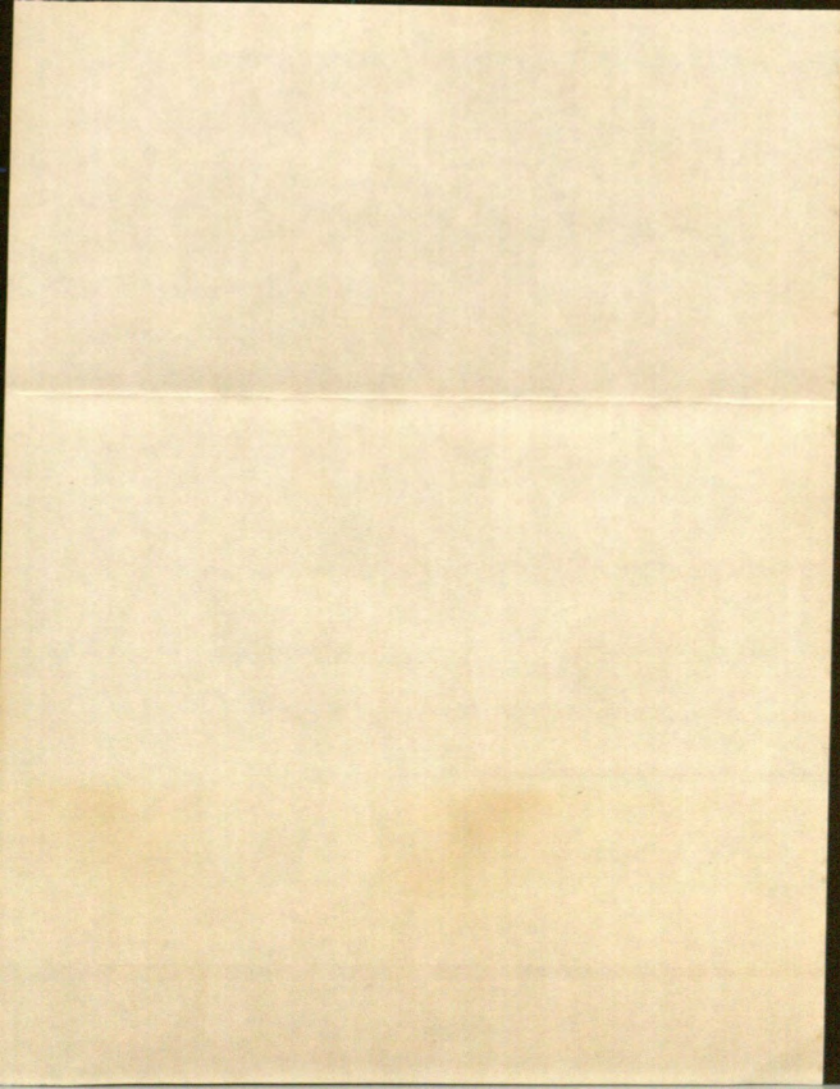
The folks are well and Dad is still an estimator
