George dearest,

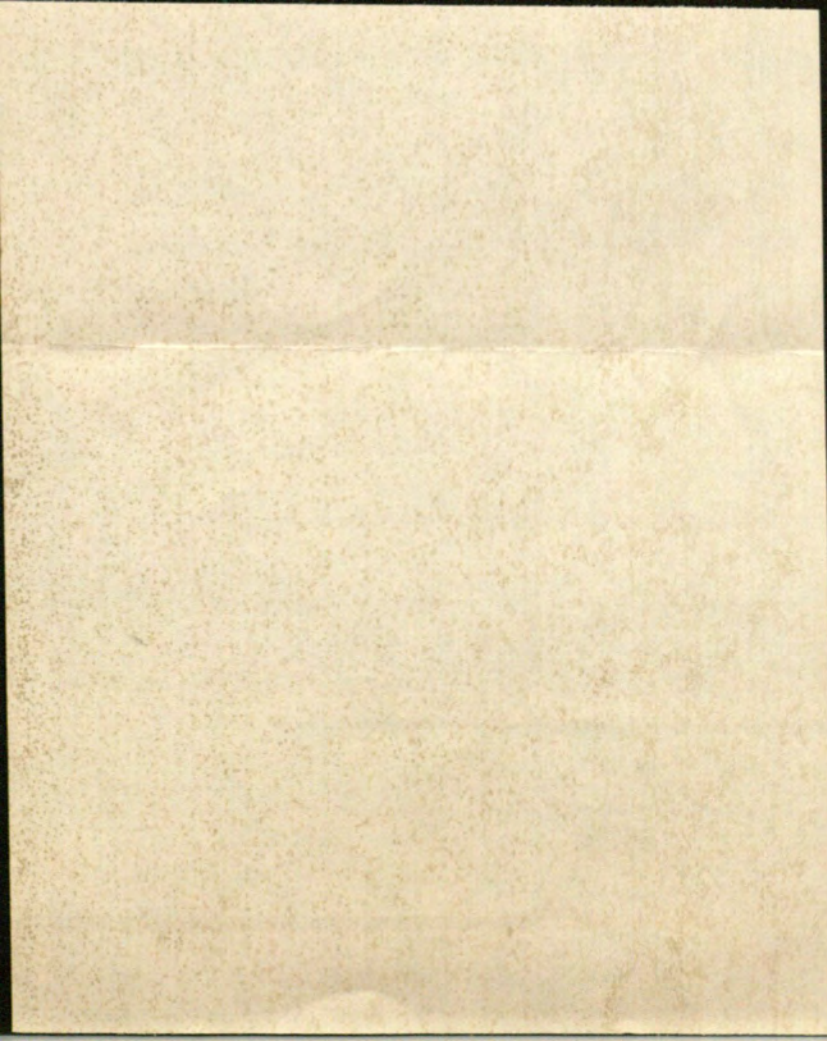

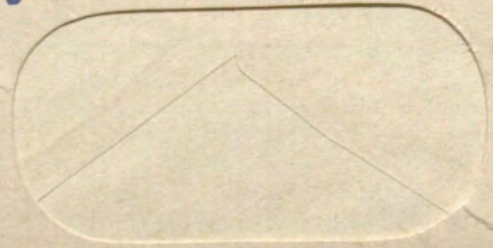
