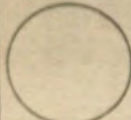

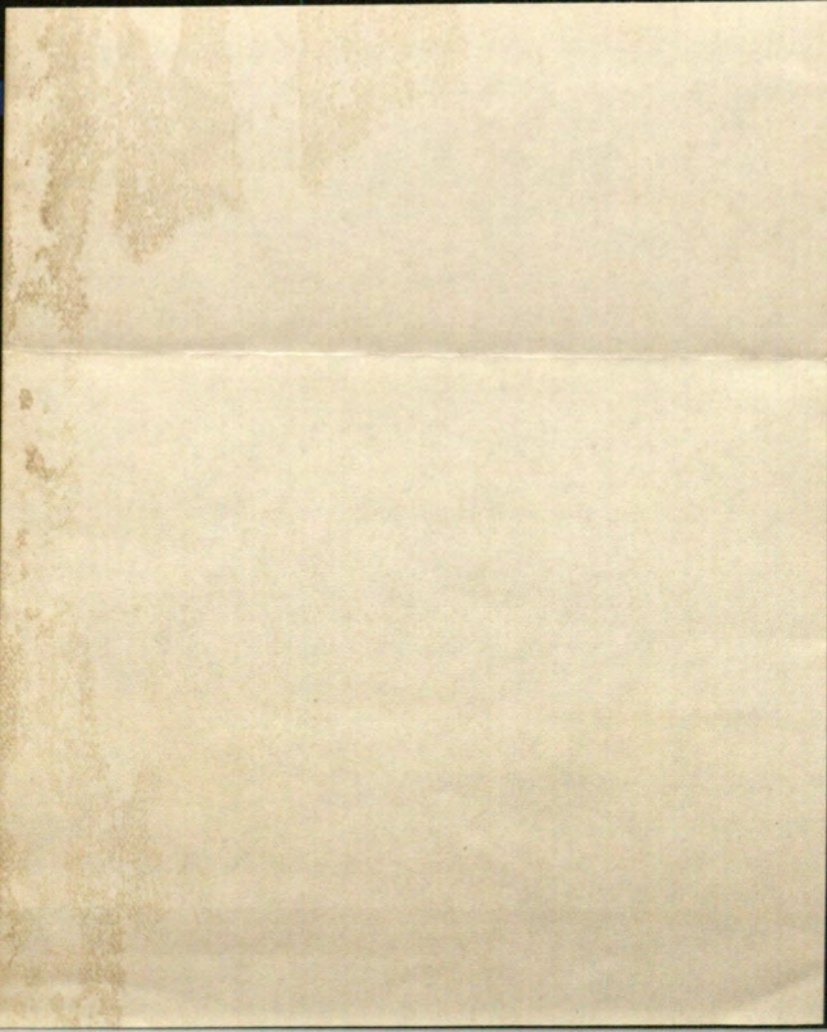
Dearest Sweetheart,
