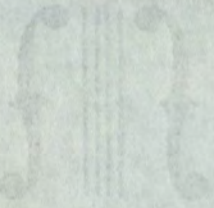
I have decided to buy Mom a dress for Mother's day. If you get the chance I want you to see that Mom looks around for something. Tell her that I told you to keep after her.
