Mom and Pop were with ~~us~~ all afternoon, Thelma and Joel came too for the afternoon. Sunny called and wants to be remembered to you.

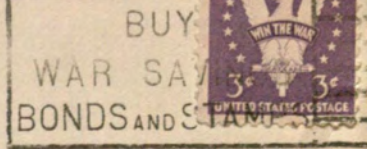
As usual Sunny Jim is the center of attraction and is getting better looking each moment.
