In the morning I do my cooking and today as a treat I made "paclari", I'll eat it hot and Betty who's getting half likes it cold. We expect to go to Lockman's tonight and then a movie if it's not too late. I did intend to go last night to the pictures but Jimmie didn't fall asleep until 8 p.m. which upset my plan and then I spoke to Bernie, Hal and Danny. All are well and send their best regards to you. Danny is now on furlough and is quite busy stepping out with the brothers. He'll write the first chance he gets, so he said last night. They all promised to pay me a visit before Hal and Bernie leave Brooklyn.

All's well on the home front. spoke to Mom this morning, she told me they received two letters from Bob saying he fussed all his exams and he's O.K. spoke to Bess who's in good spirits now and changed her plan about going away this past week to next Monday. Eleanor and Metcher and Gene and send their regards. Rose of our neighbors, Graham was put in 3D, Millie's husband (Shelley's pa) was put in the navy and

they expect another baby in 3 months. spoke to Charlie Kellner
