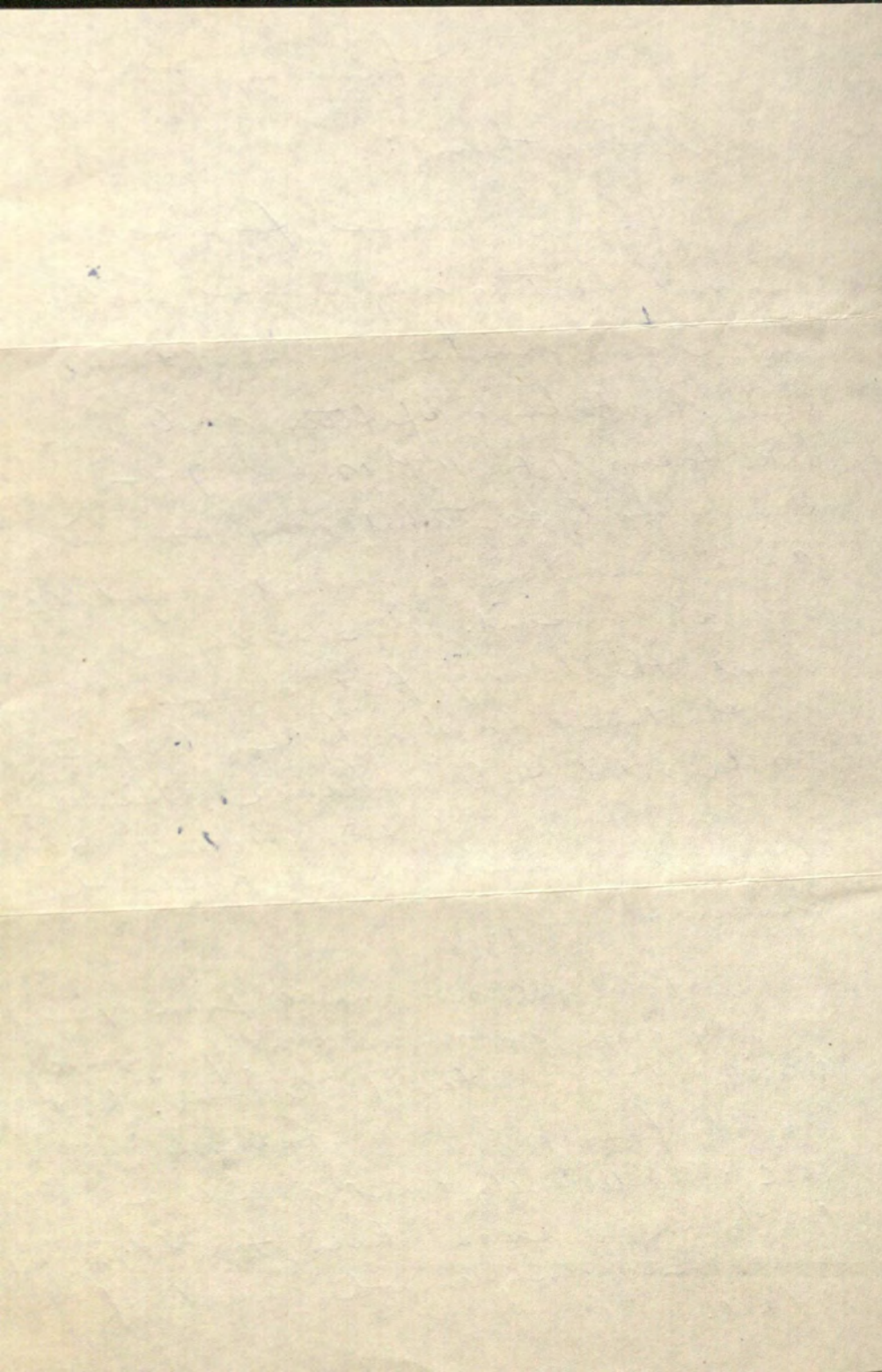


Thursday 2-24-44
