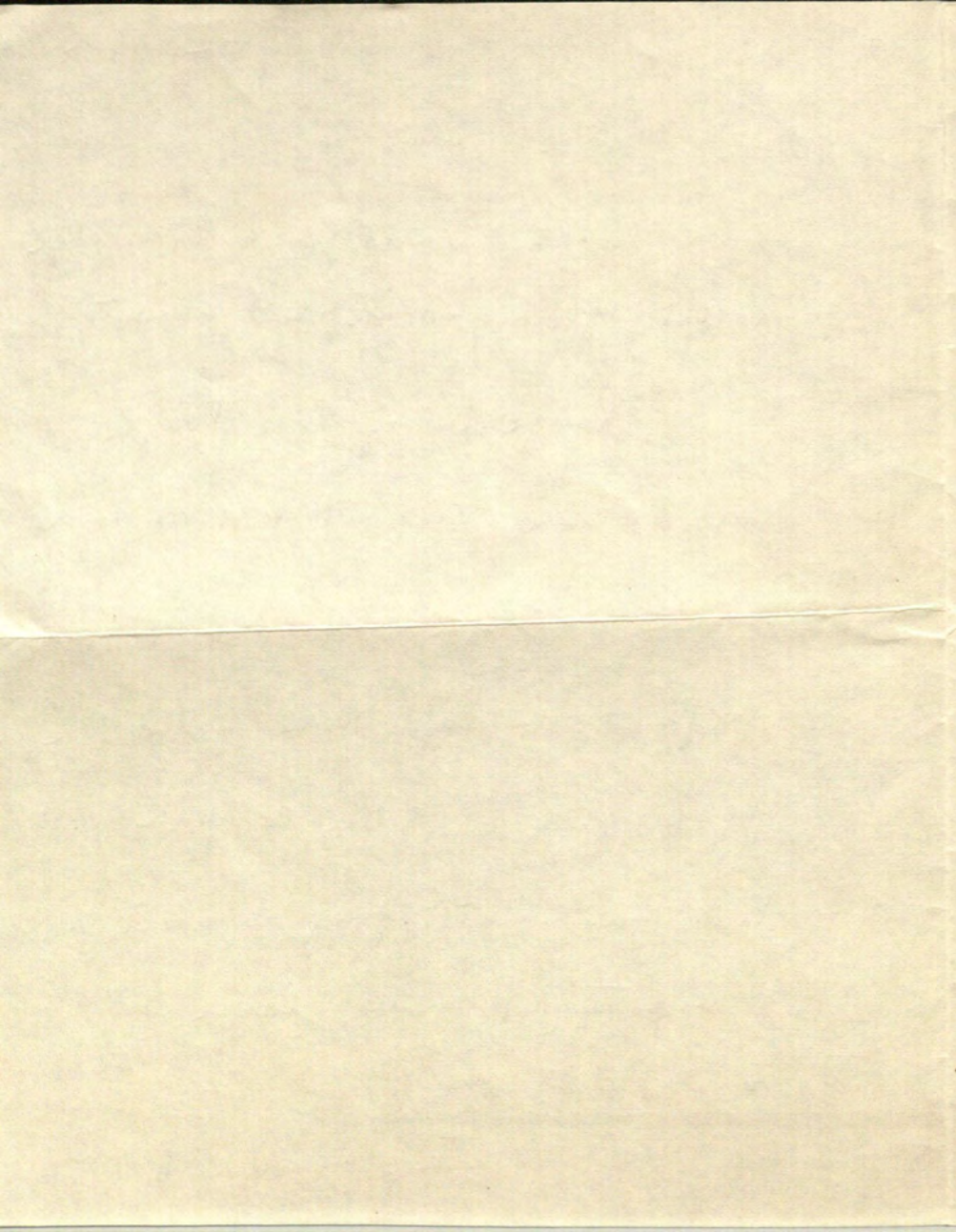
Dear George & Flo.
