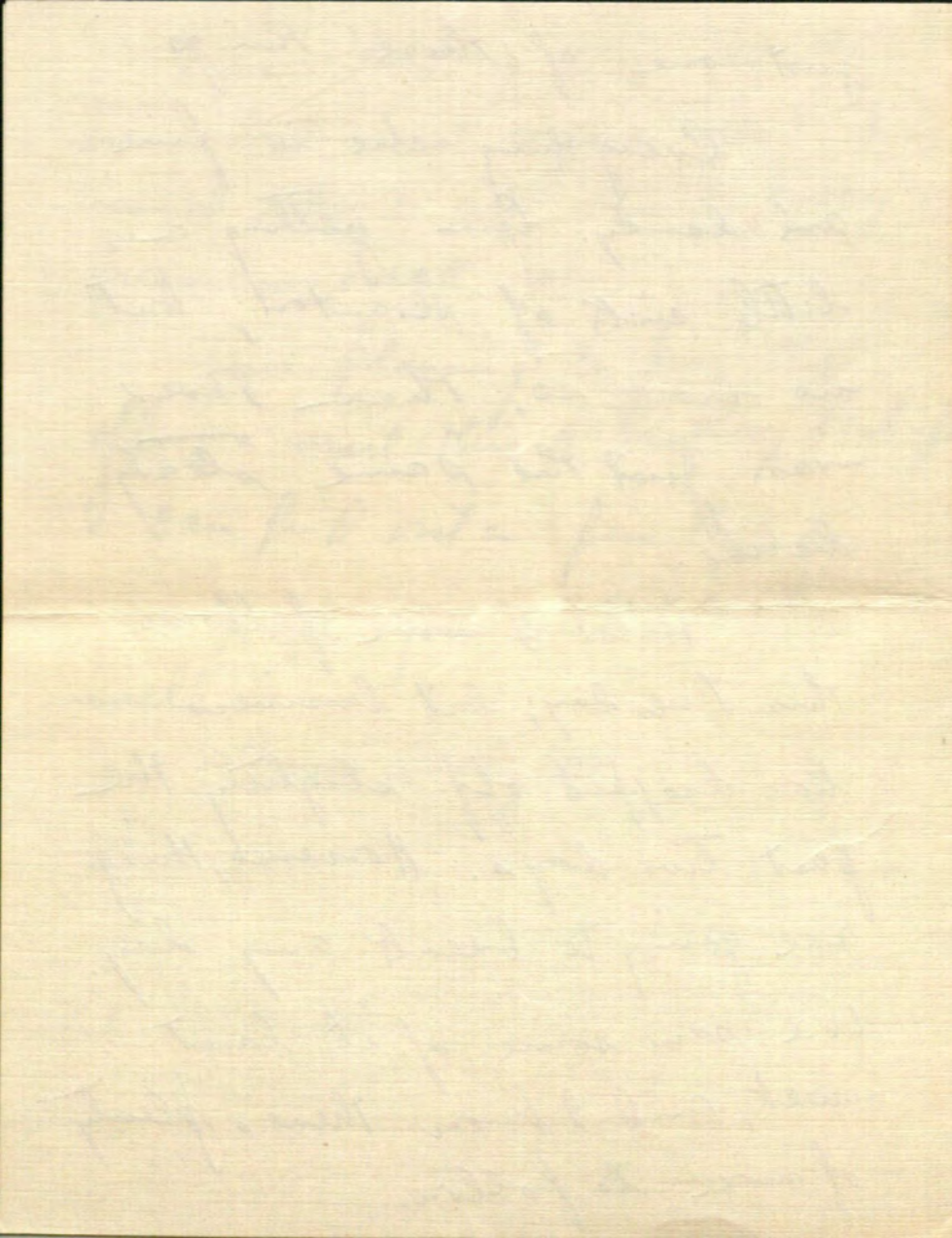
I'm keeping my pants

I can pick out a few things.

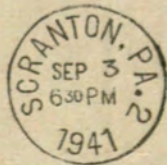
