The committee has pronounced the opinion that the pieces do not at all answer our wants, that they have more an agricultural interest than an ethnological one and that they do not possess any value for the museum. Indeed Professor Krichen is not without continually asked for objects of the same kind and I solicit you most urgently to supply us with objects, as f.i. from the Orang Semang, the Orang Sakai, the Orang Mentra etc., especially the latter being well obtainable for you.
