Abstract	The Holocaust & Genocide Studies Collection is compilation of original manuscript and printed materials that document primarily the Holocaust in Europe.

Biographical/Historical note

The Holocaust & Genocide Studies Collection is compilation of original manuscript and printed materials that document primarily the Holocaust in Europe. The materials come from a variety of donors and sources that include Norma Shaken, Katherine Larrabee Foster, Bonnie Insull, and Mary Baldwin. The collection serves as study collection for faculty and students interested in studying the holocaust.

Scope and Contents note

The Holocaust & Genocide collection was filled with many different donated pieces of history. To better organize the collection, eight different series were made to make the collection easier to understand: Correspondence, Government Documents, Stories and Reports, Clippings & Other Documents, Photographs, Artifacts, Magazines, and Oversized Items. Each series was filled with the material that corresponded with it, however some series were filled with collections that were connected to the series. Correspondence series are filled with letters. The Government Document Series is filled with passport documentation, licenses and other government documents. The Stories and Reports Series is compiled of stories and various reports of experiences during World War II. Clippings & Other Documents Series is filled with newspapers and pamphlets and other various articles printed during World War II and about World War II. The Photograph series contains photos from liberators of camps, and also the general experience of the war through people of the time. The artifact series contains the hard evidence of the period of the holocaust. Nazi arm bands, flag, and a dagger consist of the series, as well as pins from Ravensbruck, a female concentration camp, and also a Sonderkommando medal worn by prison workers in the camps. The Passport series is filled with German Passports of people who fled Europe and came to America. A majority of the passports have a red J on the cover page, symbolizing the Jewish religion. A specific passport also has manuscripts, which are connected to the person. The Magazine series is filled with American and German print dealing with the scope of the Second World War. The magazines date from the 1930's to 1960. The Oversize Materials is filled with magazines and newspapers that are too large to store with the rest of the collection but is kept with other oversized files in Flat File #2 Drawer #3 in room 133. Organizing the Holocaust & Genocide collection into these specific series helps to enable it to be utilized more efficiently.
