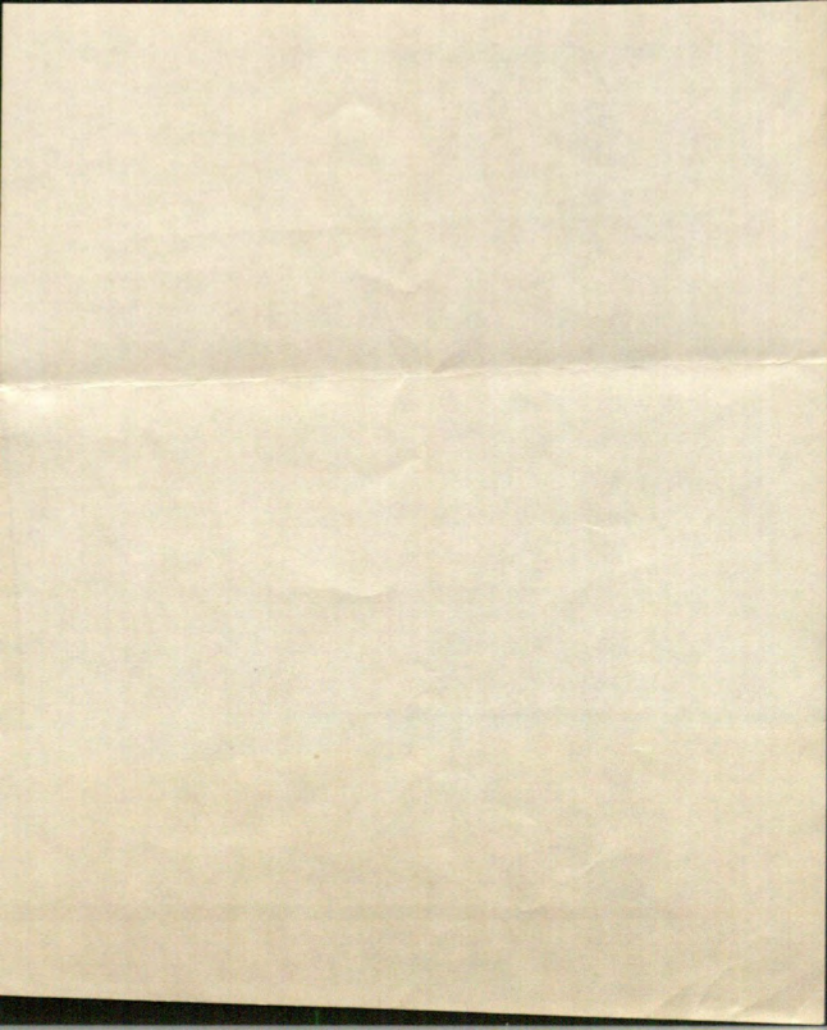
Dearest beloved,
