

Knocville Tenn.

March 20th 1864

Dear Brother:

At last after much
impatient waiting we are on our way
north we arrived here yesterday from
Morristown after a 3 days march
Go-morrow morning we start on
our long march via Jacksboro to
Nicholsville Ky there to take the
cars for Cincinnati from there we
go east and report to Annapolis Md.

It is now 12 o'clock & I have just got
the things packed up most of our
baggage goes via Cheltonovga by rail
We are glad enough to get out of Tenn.
but dread the 100 mile march

I shall try to get a furlough home
while at Annapolis but if it is not
possible I would like to have you
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the time I have not written you
for some time for the reason
that I have not had much spare
time & have not received a letter
for a long time from any one

I shall be glad ~~enough~~ enough to get
into a land of ruins & plenty once
more We hoped we were going via
C. but we don't care much if we
can only go I will try & write you
at Brunswick Please write soon &
after direct to Washington D.C.
