The French Major

consists of the following courses totaling 44 credits:

- ML 101: The World of Language
- FR 201-202: Intermediate French I & II
- FR 303: Introduction to French Literature
- FR 315: Conversation in French
- FR 316: Composition in French
- FR 320: Commercial French or FR 405: Contemporary French Usage
- FR 350: Study in France or Quebec (minimum of 12 credits)
- FR 495: Seminar
- HIST 340: The French Revolution and the Napoleonic Empire or HIST 349: France since 1815
- Three credits on French topics selected from courses such as FR 290: Intermediate Special Topics or FR 498: Independent Study with the approval of French faculty

Added to the required courses listed above, the student must then choose elective courses to reach a total of 120 credits for the degree; and 34 credits are taken in the ESEC (Education) program as noted in the "Context" narrative.

The Spanish Major

consists of the following courses, totaling 47 credits:

- ML 101: The World of Language
- SP 201-202: Intermediate Spanish I and II
- SP 303: Introduction to Spanish Literature
- SP 315: Conversation in Spanish
- SP 316: Composition in Spanish
- SP 330: Latinos in the US
- SP 350: Study in Spain or Latin America (minimum of 12 credits)
- SP 405: Contemporary Spanish Usage or SP 320: Commercial Spanish
- SP 495: Senior Seminar Capstone experience of varying topics.
- SP 498: Independent Study
- Two courses (6 credits) from the following:
 - o GEOG 345: Geography of Latin America
 - o ML 290: Selected Topics (when topic concerns Latin America, Caribbean or other Spanish-speaking cultures). Examples such as:
 - § ML 290: ST: Andean Culture (offered Spring 2004)
 - § ML 290: ST: Women in Latin America (offered Fall 2002)
 - o MU 112: Latin American Music
