Sir,

You will receive enclosed, a Resolue of Congress of the 2<sup>d</sup> Instant, directing, that all Bills which are issued in the respective States in Pursuance of the Resolution of the 10<sup>th</sup> of March 1780 after the Expiration of one Year from the Time the Interest on such Bills begins to be completed, be stamped with the Words or Characters Int. p<sup>r</sup> one, or 1/2 Year.

And that such of the said Bills as have already issued, whenever the Interest is paid, be stamped in like Manner, to prevent the Necessity & Expence of exchanging them.
