You are hereby required immediately to call on
the several Col^{ls} of the Militia hereafter named to send
to Portsmouth ^{from the things they arrived there} for the term of two months, to under the
command of Col^l Dame three hundred men in the
following proportion viz To Col^l Wentworth for
an Ensign & 12 men Col^l Evans for a Cap^t & 42 men Col^l Moulton
a Lt^l & 18 men Col^l Gilman a Cap^t & 29 men Col^l Gale Lieut^l & 27 men
Col^l Thornton Ensign & 17 men Col^l Webster an Ensign 14 men
Col^l Nichols a Cap^t & 33 men Col^l Kelly Lieut^l & 27 men Col^l Badger
Lieut^l & 20 men Col^l Shikney a Cap^t & 33 men Col^l McClary an Ensign
& 16 men

Each man to be provided with a good Muckel Cartouch box
& Blanket ^{private} to be allowed 45 Doll^{rs} p^r month & 2/ p^r mile
which will be made up in their rolls
for travel from their homes to Portsmouth their pay to
commence from the time they join Col^l Dame
with an allowance of a days pay for fifteen miles travel
and the Officers to be paid the same wages as those
gone to the Rhode Island Service - And whereas several
Col^{ls} have been deficient in sending the number of men
for the afores^d service according to an order of the 24th of July
last a list of which deficiencies is herewith transmitted
which Col^{ls} you are to notify to compleat that order. and on
their ^{or their} disobedience to proceed with them according to Military
law
