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York Town 11th May 1778.

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By the common Post this Morning
I directed a Packet to Your Honor which contained 10 Copies
of an Address by Congress to the Inhabitants of the United
States of America & 2 or 3 Copies of a Proclamation forbid-
ding Malpractices of Captains Commanders & other Officers
& Sailors belonging to American Armed Vessels both
land & at Sea.

ten more Copies of the former & 3 of the latter Act.

the contents of these Papers to the good People in the
State of New Hampshire.
