Biographical/Historical note

Founded in 1981 by Bonnie Riley of Francestown, New Hampshire, the "Tuesday Academy" is an informal, adult education study group comprised of women from the Monadnock region of New Hampshire. The group meets regularly on Tuesday mornings to discuss selected readings in a variety of subject areas including History, Government, Art, Science and Literature. The curriculum is supplemented by special events, presentations and performances, and food. For additional history of the organization, see Box 1, Folder 2, "Tuesday Academy Conversation" (Tuesday, April 24, 2012).

Scope and Contents note

The Tuesday Academy collection ranges from dates 1996-2011, and is 1.5 linear feet. Included in the collection are the history of the organization, members of the organization - which include addresses and phone numbers - poetry, and celebrations written and put on by the group. Also included are recipes from New England, and different parts of the country and of the world. Since the group had an academic focus, there are also curricula included. Programs of study included in this collection are Science, History, and Literature. Accompanying materials included are photos, and VHS tapes.
