Dear Friends:

As you see by the
heading of this letter we are all
back again to Knoxville I wrote
you this letter at Morristown and
as I had just got it completed
we had orders to move back and
report to Annapolis Md. after three
days marching we have got so far
and are resting before starting on
our long march of 200 miles
over the mountains We have expected
until to-day to go via Chattanooga
but we are now ordered over the
mountains It will take us 8 days
to march to Nicholasville & probably
2 or 3 more to get to Annapolis Maryland

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all the things I want to write with me
I suppose we are soon off on our
expedition. I shall try if possible get
a furlough home but I don't much
expect to succeed as I am here at
Gen. Millev's headquarters who now
commands the 9th Corps. It is
not so easy to get a furlough here
as at the Company but I have a
much easier time here than if
with the Reg. & Co. I have nothing to
carry on the march & it don't make me
very tired to march 20 miles a day.
I expect to get my box at Nicholasville
so all I have written about the box are
for things from home you may
consider null & void for you need
not send me anything. I have
been well & tough since you heard
from me last I have received no
letters from home for a long time.
I want you to write often Direct to
Co D. 11th N.Y. Vols. 2d Brigade 2d Div. 8th Army
Corps Washington D.C.

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I suppose we are soon off on an expedition I shall try & if possible get a furlough home but I don't much expect to succeed as I am here at Gen. Wilcox headquarters who now commands the 9th Corps. It is not so easy to get a furlough here as at the Company but I have a much easier time here than if with the Reg. & Co. I have nothing to carry on the march & it don't make me very tired to march 20 miles a day I expect to get my box at Nickolsville so all I have written about the box or for things from home you may consider null & void for you need not send me anything. I have been well & tough since you heard from me last I have received no letters from home for a long time I want you to write often Direct to Co D. 11th NH. Vols. 2^d Brigade 2^d Div. 9th Army Corps Washington DC.
