I inclose you two Resolves of Congress one of June the 2^d the other of the 8th by which you will see what has been done with regard to the newhampshire grants and the several Claimants - I find a very grate backwardness in many of the members of Congress to proceed on this business untill the conclusion of the war - and the members continually coming & going it is impossible to foresee what opinion Congress may be off three months hence with regard to putting a final end to these unhappy disputes
