To the Committee of Safety of the State of New
Hampshire - Gentlemen

Having rec^d a Line from Col^l Bodlet that the
Governor of Kingston have advanced the Sum of five Hundred
Dollars being the Money I paid for Two men I made
a Return of one I left for Two years the other
during the War which the Col^l says the Committee has
agreed to let to this Town of Kingston but by some
mistake he says the Return is not to be found
and therefore desires a farther Return

I now Return with the Two men aforesaid Four
men in the Whole Namely Richard Griffin of Mynmouth
during the War for 320 Dollars in Capt Stones Company
Stephen Fears of Mynmouth for Two years 213 ¹/₃
dollars in said Stones Company Daniel Croft of Mynmouth
for Two years for 213 ¹/₃ dollars in said Stones Company

Jacob Burkhardt ^{of Mynmouth} for Three years for Three Hundred Dollars
Who served Mynthes with the Maj^r Whiles but in whose
unknown from Gentlemen Your Servant
