The United States in Congress assembled
May 11th 1781

The Com^{ee} on the letter of 8th from General Washington
delivered in a Report whereupon

Resolved, That it be earnestly recommended
to the executive authority in the several States from New-
hampshire to Pennsylvania inclusive to forward on to
such place ~~as the Director Master~~ as the Director Master
General shall direct at the expence of the respective
States in the first instance all such supplies of provisions
as they have been called ^{upon} to furnish by the resolution of
Congress of the 15th of November last and that all such
necessary expence as any of the said States are at
in transporting the provisions aforesaid ~~to the~~
~~destination~~ shall be placed to the credit of the States
respectively —
