

Note to 9/11 Group . Keene Square 7/3/08

Thank you for allowing me three minutes to speak. You will be surprised how much can be said in that short amount of time

We do not know what the future holds for our dear nation or for the world. If you think of the physical challenges before us: the earth's climate, its food supply, its fresh water resources, its energy resources, we might as well be facing some science fiction disaster movie. But we will move ahead and do whatever we can do to survive.

In the year 2000 I was arrested with a group of 30 others for a civil disobedience when we spoke in the People's Room of our Nations' Capitol building. If found guilty we were to serve six months in jail and pay a fine of \$500. But our judge made a statement which I think could be as well said of the Monadnock Truth Alliance of 9/11. He said, as I remember it: "You are the vanguard for the masses. You are brave people speaking for those masses, trying to awake them to the truth. You will be ridiculed by those masses for ridicule is a powerful weapon that makes you embarrassed, a bit ashamed before your neighbors, your children and your friends. They make you want to be one of those masses. But

your alliance started only a year and a half ago, is making waves and we are here this evening to hear wise words from one who has given up his life for this cause *Dr. Brown*

We are facing the hard truth to choose one man that we really do not know, to be our next president, almost a mystical figure, or another man who is likeable, funny, and I speak from experience, for I walked 3,200 miles for his Campaign Finance Reform bill, which he has since questioned, though I am still wearing the pair of sneakers he bought for me. He is A fantastic hero, who cannot make up his mind and changes what he thinks as often as New Hampshire weather. We salute the Monadnock Truth Alliance of 9/11.
