Cheryl, Sweet heart,

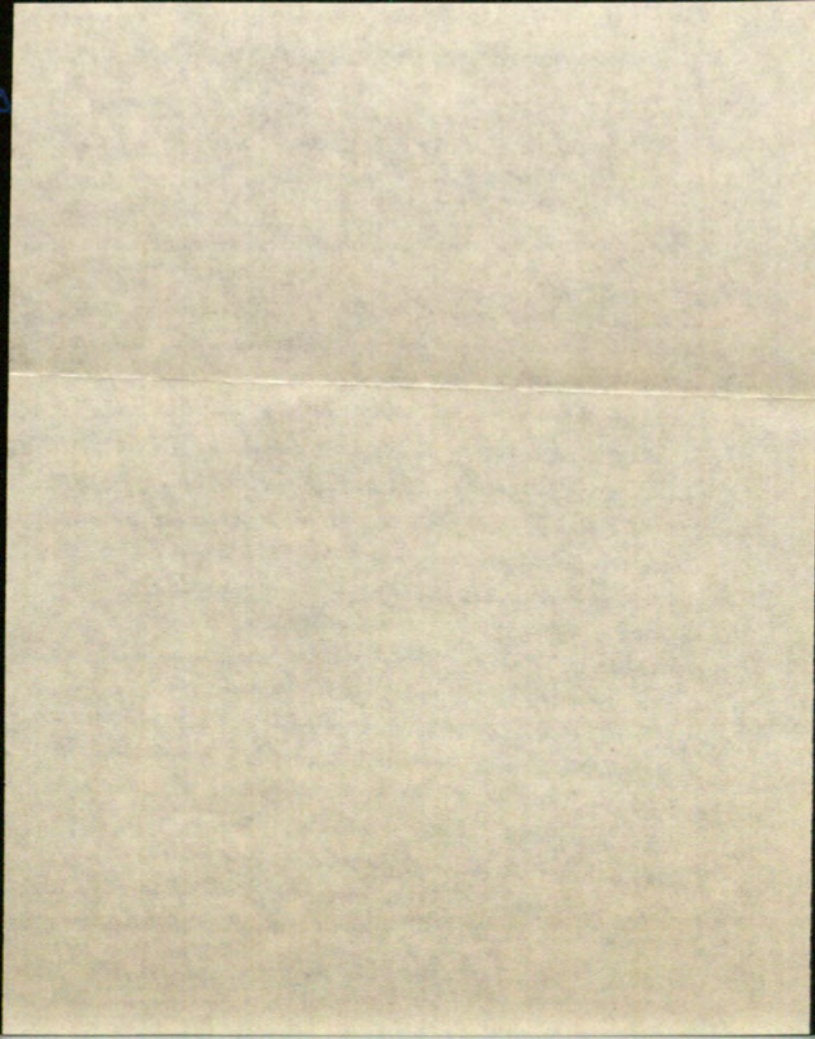
