Dearest beloved -

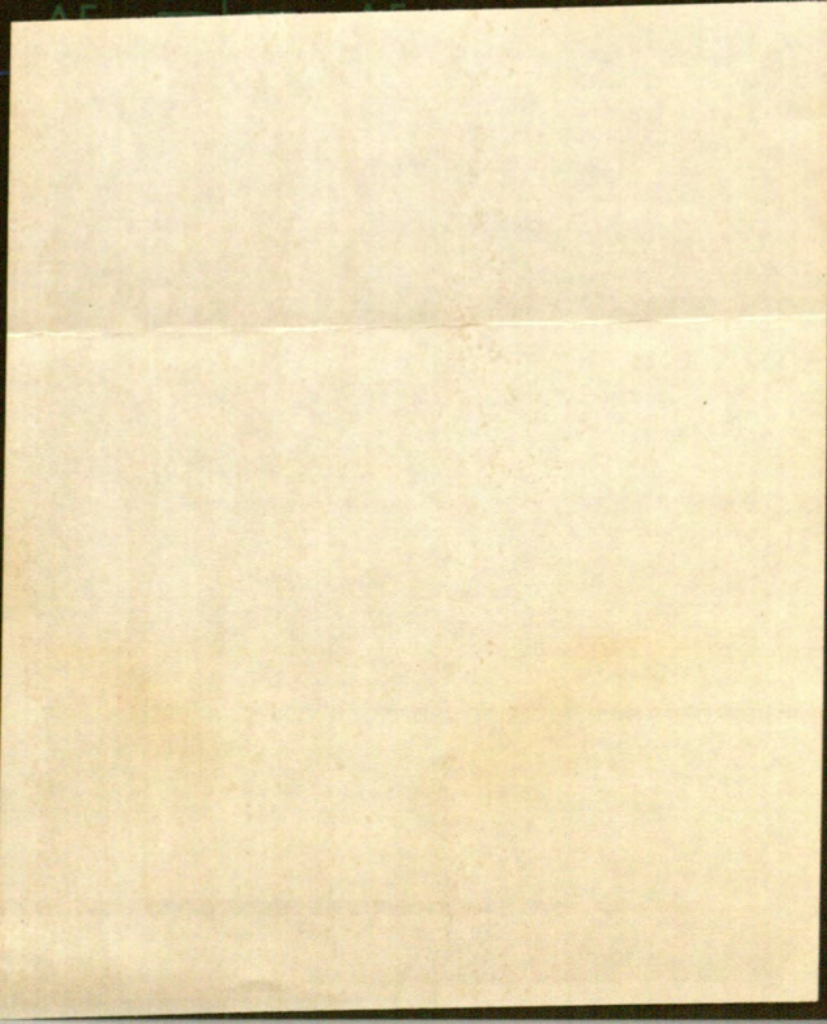
