Hon^{rs} Gentlemen

I suppose I have received the Laste Orders dated the
10th Instant, no pains are wanting to collect
the ~~Continental~~ Soldiers, I am this day musterring
them, neare together and mustered, and
suppose the Remains will be here by
tomorrow, moste of the Rhodisland Soldiers
are already mustered, I wish to know
what I am to do with both, Continental
and Rhodislan Soldiers, as here is no offen to
Receive either, I could also wish, to know
whether the Continental Soldiers that first
for a yeare Onely, are Intitled to a sute of
Cloathing, I have not to add, I keep an answer
by the Bearer, in the meentime I am
Gentlemen with the greater Esteem and
Respect your Hon^{rs} moste obedient Humble
