YOUR APRIL 3RD, 4TH AND 6TH LETTERS ARRIVED THIS MORNING. GLAD TO KNOW THAT YOU ARE FINE AND DANDY AND AS CHEERFUL ABOUT THE LATEST NEWS AS WE ARE. YESTERDAY I WROTE A LONG LETTER AND SENT IT REGULAR MAIL. ALSO MAILED YOU AN OTHER PARCEL CONTAINING SWEATERS FOR HENRIKA AND VITAMIN PILLS FOR YOU.

AS I MENTIONED YESTERDAY, I DROVE YOUR POLKS OUT TO ROCKAWAY TO VISIT AARON, WHO IS HOME AND YOUR AUNT SOPHIE. ALL THE FAMILY IS WELL AND EVERYONE SENDS REGARDS TO YOU.
