Whereas Nathanael Sanborn of Hampton aforesaid
Husbandman was this Day brought before me One
of his Majestys Justices of the Peace for s^d Province
being charged by Hannah Lane of Hampton aforesaid
Singlewoman and Spinster to have begotten her with
Child & the said Nathanael having before me
Refused to find Sureties for his appearance at the
next Court of General Sessions of the Peace for the
Province aforesaid to be holden at Portsmouth in
December next, to Answer to the said Charge

These are therefore in his Majestys Name to
Require you the said Sherriff Under Sherriff or Deputy
or Constable aforesaid forthwith Safely to Convey
the said Nathanael Sanborn to his Majestys Goal
in Portsmouth in said Province And him Deliver to
the keeper of said Goal. Hereby also Commanding
you the said keeper of said Goal to Receive the
Said Nathanael into your Custody And him safely
to keep in said Goal untill he shall be from thence
Discharged by Due Course of Law: Hereof fail not.
Dated at Hampton falls in said Province the first
Day of November in the Eleventh year of his
Majestys Reign Annoque Domini 1770
