You will receive, herewith enclosed, a copy of an act of Congress of this day earnestly recommending it to the several States to exert themselves in furnishing the allied Armies in America with such aids of Men & Provisions as may enable them to operate effectually against the common Enemy, & expel them from this Country.

The Reasons for this Recommendation are fully assigned in the Preamble to the Resolution -- You bear therefore to multiply Arguments to induce a compliance with a Requisition which every motive of Interest, Safety, Honor, & Regard to the Alliance loudly call upon every American to regard & fulfill.
